WHO CAN APPLY

Eligibility

Program cost

The discounted program rate for RISSB members is \$3,049 (ex GST) (non-RISSB members \$3,353.90 ex GST) and covers all face-to-face forums, online mentoring sessions, completion and debrief of individual DISC Profile, and three networking events.
